Proper Completion of Land Disposal Notification Form Speeds Up Processing Of Wastes

Thorough and accurate completion of the Land Disposal Notification Form is a prerequisite to the timely storage and processing of waste materials at a treatment, storage or disposal facility (TSDF).

Generators are required by regulation to complete the Land Disposal Notification Form for any wastes subject to the land disposal restrictions. This form must then be properly retained by the TSDF. Representatives of the Ohio and United States Environmental Protection Agencies will often review the land disposal notification forms for generators when they conduct inspections at the TSDF facility.

To assist customers who are required to complete the LDR notification form, Ross Transportation drivers bring a copy of the form to the customer when they arrive to pick up the waste materials for delivery to a TSDF.

Customers who use another transportation company can call (1-800-878-7677) or email (customerservice@rossenvironmental.com) the Ross Environmental Services Customer Service Department to request a copy of the land ban form for their shipment. The Customer Service staff will fax or email the form to them.

Submittal of the form is required for waste materials that are subject to the LDR requirements. Ross Environmental requests that generators sign and date a new form with each applicable shipment of waste sent to a TSDF.

When Completing the Land Ban Notification Form, Remember:

- Check the generator name and location and the U.S. EPA ID number to see that they are accurate.
- Number the top of each page (page 1 of 2 pages, etc.) so that the TSDF employees will know that they have all of the necessary pages of the form.
- Be sure the manifest number appears on each page and matches the manifest for the shipment.
- ♦ At the bottom of the first page, check YES, if underlying hazardous constituents and/or regulated hazardous constituents are present in the waste stream.
- Be certain to fill out the back page of the form—indicating which of the underlying hazardous constituents is reasonably expected to be in the waste. A listing of constituents is provided for you to check as appropriate.
- Complete a Land Disposal Notification Form for each shipment of applicable waste materials.
